## **INVITATION TO BID**

Umsobomvu Local Municipality (ULM) invites tenders from relevant, suitably qualified and experienced service providers for **Upgrading of Existing VIP Toilets to Full Waterborne Sanitation System in Kuyasa: Bid No.: 01/11/2018**. The works consists of: Construction of sewer reticulation and building of free standing toilet structures in both Masiphakame and Zwelitsha areas.

It is estimated that the contractor must have a CIDB grading of **4CEPE, 5CE** or higher. Only tenderers who satisfy the eligibility criteria stated in the Tender Conditions and Tender Data are eligible to submit tenders. Potential emerging enterprises who satisfy criteria stated in the Tender Data may submit tenders.

A non-refundable deposit of **R 500.00** payable in cash or by bank guaranteed cheque made out in favour of the employer is required on collection of the document.

A compulsory briefing meeting by the representatives of the Employer will take place at the municipal offices of **Umsobomvu Municipality at 21A Church Street, Colesberg, 9795 on Thursday, 15 November 2018** starting at 10:00. Only contractors who attend the compulsory site inspection meeting are eligible to submit their tenders. For contractors who will submit their offer as a joint venture, only one party to the joint venture need to attend the compulsory briefing meeting.

The closing time for receipts of tenders is **12:00, Friday, 07 December 2018**. Sealed tenders, endorsed with the corresponding tender number and description, **UPGRADING OF EXISTING VIP TOILETS TO FULL WATERBORNE SANITATION SYSTEM IN KUYASA: BID NO. 1/11/2018** must be placed in the tender box at the office of Umsobomvu Municipality in Colesberg. Postal delivery to reach Umsobomvu Municipality, Private Bag X6, Colesberg, 9795, not later than **12:00 on Friday, 07 December 2018**, after which the tenders will be opened in public. Telegraphic, telephonic, telex, facsimile, e-mail and late tenders will not be accepted.

The Umsobomvu Procurement and Supply Chain Management Policies, the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, Act No. 5 of 2000 and the regulations promulgated under this Act shall apply in the evaluation and awarding of the tender

Declaration of Interest forms are available on the web-site ([www.umsobomvumun.co.za](http://www.umsobomvumun.co.za)) which must be filled out and submitted with the tender.

### **TENDERERS SHOULD TAKE NOTE OF THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS**

- All tenderers, including Joint Ventures and Consortiums must be registered on the Central Suppliers Database (log on [www.csd.gov.za](http://www.csd.gov.za) for registration and the tax status on the CSD must be compliant.
- A current original SARS Tax Clearance Certificate or a SARS Verification PIN must be supplied.
- An approved formal performance guarantee will be required from the awarded tender; a letter of intent to provide this guarantee, from an approved company/state entity shall be submitted with the tender for it to be responsive.
- Tenderers must attach completion certificates of the projects they have completed, signed by the accounting officer or delegated official in accordance with the criteria stated in order to be assessed for functionality.
- A company profile of the tenderer with full curriculum vitae of the proposed team must be submitted stating whether team members will be full time or part time on the project, their roles and responsibilities.
- Certified ID Copies of company Directors to be included on the bid.

- All tenders should hold good for 90 days from closing date.
- Tenderers must submit a certificate certifying that the tenderer has no undisputed commitments for municipal services towards a municipality or service provider i.r.o. payments which is overdue more than 30 days.
- Audited financial statements must be submitted with the tender covering at least three previous financial years (if the tendered amount exceeds R10 million including VAT).
- Proof of good standing with the Workman's Compensation Fund must be submitted with the tender for it to be responsive.
- Tenderers must take note that 30% project cost must be subcontracted to local SMME's.
- Statement of goods or services sourced from outside the RSA, and if so what portion and whether any portion of payment from the municipality is expected to be transferred out of the Republic.
- Tenderers must submit certified evidence of BBBEE status issued by SANAS, IRBA or SANAS accredited agents to claim preference points. In the case of Joint Venture or a Consortium, a consolidated BBBEE certificate for JV parties should be submitted.
- Tenders to be completed with **BLACK INK** only
- Umsobomvu Municipality does not bind itself to accept the lowest tender or any tender, and reserves the right to accept the whole or part of the tender.
- **NO TENDERS WILL BE CONSIDERED FROM PERSONS IN THE SERVICE OF THE STATE.**
- Tenderers will have to score a **minimum of 60 out of 100 points** for functionality in order to qualify to be assessed for price and preference. The criteria according to which functionality will be scored are contained in the tender document.

Price and preference will be evaluated on the following criteria:

Price	= 80 points,
BBBEE status level of contribution	= 20 points
<b>TOTAL</b>	<b>= 100 points</b>
