A compulsory briefing session with representatives of the Employer will take place at the Municipal offices in, **Noupoot, Municipal offices, No.6 Shaw street, Noupoot**, on **22nd July 2021** starting at **12H00**. Persons arriving later than **12H15** will not be allowed into the meeting. Only tenderers who attend the compulsory briefing session are eligible to submit their proposals.

NOTE: COVID 19 LEVEL 4 REGULATIONS WILL APPLY ON DAY OF BRIEFING SESSION AND CLOSING DATE, NO MASK NO ENTRY.

The closing time for receipts of tenders is **12H00, 20 August 2021**. Bids must be completed in black ink, enclosed in sealed tenders, endorsed with the corresponding notice number and description, **THE UPGRADING OF NOUPOORT SEWER NETWORK: TENDER No. UMS/WSIG/07/2021**, must be placed in the tender box at the office of Umsobomvu Municipality, **21 A Church Street, COLESBERG, 9795**, not later than 12H00 on **20 August 2021**. after which tenders will be opened in public shortly afterwards.

The municipality will not repeat any matters already covered in the compulsory briefing meeting to the bidders who arrive more than 15 minutes late to the meeting, nor will it allow such bidders to complete the attendance register. Any bid received from a bidder who did not attend the briefing meeting and sign the attendance register will not be considered and will be returned to the bidder unopened.

Bids which are deposited late, Telegraphic, telephonic, facsimile, e-mailed electronically will not be considered.

It must be expressly understood that the municipality accepts no responsibility for ensuring that bid on submissions sent by courier or post or delivered in any other way, are deposited in the tender box, it is therefore preferable for the bidder to ensure that its bids submission is placed in the Tender Box by its own staff or representatives.

Prospective Bidders must take note that the following tender conditions, and including requirements listed on the tender data will apply. (Failure to submit any of the following and those listed on the tender data will result in disqualification)

- Fully completed tender document.
- All bids submitted should remain valid for a period of **120 days** after the bid closing date.
- A Valid original SARS pin number and current tax Clearance Certificate.
- Certified copies of company founding statement (CK)
- Copies of directors' ID document and all submitted certificates must be original certified.
- Company profile with traceable references
- Bidders are required to submit Proposed Project Team, their CV's and qualifications.
- CIDB Grading certificate minimum of required grading.
- Proof of latest municipal rates, taxes and municipal services statement indicating that rates, taxes and municipal services charges are not in arrears for more than 3 months, or if the property for your business is being leased to the bidder, then a lease agreement must be submitted.
- Company directors' statement of Municipal Accounts (Not older than three Month) must also be attached.
- Audited annual financial statements of the bidding entity (for more projects in excess of **R10 million**)
- Joint Venture agreement should be in CIDB JV agreement format and joint venture BBBEE must be combined. • Bidders are required to submit original and valid BBBEE, status level verification certificates or certified copies thereof together with their bids, to substantiate their BBBEE rating claims, failure to submit will result in zero points score for BBBEE status level.
- All bidders must be registered on the Central Suppliers Database and active on at least on the date of closing this bid. (log on www.csd.gov.za) for registration,
- Bidders must also take note that, Umsobomvu Municipality will not appoint and or enter into contract with service providers who their tax matters are non-compliant, however 7 days will be allowed for any successful bidder to make good of their tax matters prior appointment.
- Bids submitted by persons in the service of government (national, provincial, local or SOCs') will not be considered.
- All MBD forms must be completed accurately (MBD1, MBD2, MBD4, MBD6.1, MBD6.2, MBD 7.1, MBD 8, MBD 9).
- Proof of subcontracting at least 30% of the works to any designated enterprises, as stipulated in this document;
- This bid is subject to the General Conditions of Contract (GCC) and, if applicable, any other Special Conditions of Contract.

BIDS WILL BE EVALUATED ON THE BASIS OF PREFERENTIAL PROCUREMENT POLICY FRAMEWORK ACT NO 5, OF 2000 (PPFFA) AND REGULATION PERTAINING THERE TO (2017)

BIDS WILL BE EVALUATED IN THREE STAGES NAMELY:

- Stage 1- Prequalification criteria
- Stage 2 – Functionality, ≥ 70 points (full details of functionality scores are in the tender data)
- Stage 3 - Financial offer and Preference, Price = 80 points, BBBEE contribution level = 20 points.

The Municipality reserves the right not to accept the only or lowest priced tender or any tender at all or accept the whole or part of any tender and or if:

- a) The tender amounts received are too high;
- b) The tenders do not comply with specific tender goals.
- c) Objective criteria exist which justify or necessitate the non-acceptance of any tenders

The Umsobomvu Procurement and Supply Chain Management Policies, the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, Act No. 5 of 2000 and the regulations promulgated under this Act shall apply in the evaluation and awarding of the tender.

PREFERENTIAL PROCUREMENT POLICY FRAMEWORK ACT NO 5, 2000 (PPPFA) POINTS WILL BE AWARDED AS FOLLOWS:-

THE BIDS WILL BE EVALUATED IN THREE STAGES NAMELY:

- Stage 1- Prequalification criteria
- Stage 2 – Functionality, ≥ 70 points (full details of functionality scores are in the tender data)
- Stage 3 - Financial offer and Preference, Price = 80 points, BBBEE contribution level = 20 points.

STAGE 1 – PRE-QUALIFICATION CRITERIA

In terms of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act 2000, Preferential Procurement Regulation 2017, pre-qualification criteria for preferential procurement as specified in Regulation 4 will apply.

- (i) an EME or QSE which is at least 51% owned by black people;
- (ii) an EME or QSE which is at least 51% owned by Black people who are youth;
- (iii) an EME or QSE which is at least 51% owned by Black people who are women;
- (iv) an EME or QSE which is at least 51% owned by Black people living in rural or underdeveloped areas or townships;
- (v) a cooperative which is at least 51% owned by black people;
- (vi) an EME or QSE which is at least 51% owned by Black people who are military veterans;
- (vii) an EME or QSE.

Failure to meet the pre-qualification criteria will render a bid non-responsive, and such bid will be disqualified and not proceed to be evaluated further.
